

MAJOR REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST

The Sociology major requires a total of 50 credits:

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS		
In addition to admission prerequisites, students must complete the following:		
SOCIAL SCIENCE STATISTICS (5 CREDITS)	COURSE	QTR/YR
STAT 220 or 290 (AP credit) may be used instead of SOC 221.	SOC 221	
SOCIOLOGICAL THEORY (5 CREDITS)	SOC 316	
We strongly recommend that students complete Statistics and Theory courses BEFORE starting upper division coursework.		
ADVANCED SOCIOLOGY COURSEWORK (20 CREDITS)		
300/400-level numerically graded courses. Students may use 5 credits of Practicum coursework (402, 403, 404, or 494) toward this requirement. SOC 395 and SOC 3XX/4XX may not be used.		
SOCIOLOGY ELECTIVES (10 CREDITS)		
Sociology coursework at any level. Maximum 5 credits total of SOC 399/SOC 499 (graded CR/NC).		

ADDITIONAL ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum cumulative UW GPA of 2.00
- Minimum UW SOC GPA of 2.50
NOTE: Transfer (or Running Start) students who apply in their first quarter at UW may meet the above requirements with their transfer coursework

ADDITIONAL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum grade of 2.0 in each course used toward major requirements.
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 in all **UW Sociology/Statistics** courses used toward major requirements. Courses that do not count toward major requirements will not be included in the GPA calculation.
- Minimum of 25 credits taken in residence at University of Washington.
