# **Emergency Procedures/Safety Plan**

## University of Washington Department of Sociology

#### **FIRE**

Pull fire alarm and call 911.

Use fire extinguisher if you know how and it is a small fire (garbage can size or smaller)

Evacuate building, if necessary (use stairwells, not elevators; assist disabled persons to stairwells).

Reassemble on the Quad Lawn, Southeast of Savery.

#### **VOLCANO**

Close windows, doors, cabinets.

Turn off and cover office equipment.

#### **EARTHQUAKE**

Get under desk, table, or doorway.

Beware of collapsing bookshelves or falling objects.

Evacuate building, if necessary (use stairwells, not elevators; assist disabled persons to stairwells).

If evacuation is necessary reassemble on the Quad Lawn, Southeast of Savery.

#### CALLS TO MAKE

Medical Emergency: 911 and/or pull nearest fire alarm Life threatening confrontation: 911 and/or pull nearest fire alarm

Suspicious person/activity 911
Bomb Scare/Threat and Suspicious Package 911
Toxic Vapors/Chemical Spills 911
Explosion 911
